


Rules Governing The Scatter Garden
First Evangelical Lutheran Church

Lexington, NC 27292

1. The use of the Scatter Garden is under the exclusive control of the Columbarium Team as designated by the Congregational Council of First Evangelical Lutheran Church of Lexington, NC. No individual shall acquire any right whatsoever with respect to the use or appearance of the Scatter Garden. The Columbarium Team may remove, alter, modify or relocate the Scatter Garden or any related markers or other items connected therewith at its sole discretion.
2. Placement of cremains in the Scatter Garden shall be limited to baptized members of the Congregation and immediate family members of such individuals. Others may be placed with the special approval by a majority of the Columbarium Team.
3. The cremains of any person accepted for scattering may be scattered in the Scatter Garden at such location as is designated by the Columbarium Team in its sole discretion. None of the cremains will be recoverable or preserved intact.
4. The names of persons whose cremains are scattered in the Scatter Garden will be entered in a Memorial Register maintained by the Columbarium Team.
5. The Scatter Garden, as part of the ministry of First Evangelical Lutheran Church, does not require a fee for usage; however, memorial gifts will be received with much appreciation.
6. The Columbarium Team shall, from time to time, adopt administrative rules and regulations pertaining to the use, appearance, maintenance, improvement and perpetuation of the Scatter Garden and Memorial Register.
7. No scattering of cremains or any memorial service to be held in the Scatter Garden shall be conducted without the approval, and presence of, the currently called pastor of First Evangelical Lutheran Church of Lexington, NC, or his or her designated representative.
8. No flowers, plants or decorations of any kind shall be placed in the Columbarium at any time, other than the landscaping, which is overseen, installed and maintained by the Columbarium Team. If any flowers, plants or decorations are placed, without the authority of the Columbarium Team, the Columbarium Team reserves the right to have any such articles removed and disposed of without notice.

ADOPTION

These rules were adopted by the Columbarium Team and ratified by the Church Council of First Evangelical Lutheran Church as of August 10, 2014, and may be amended from time to time upon recommendation of the Team and upon ratification by the Church Council.
